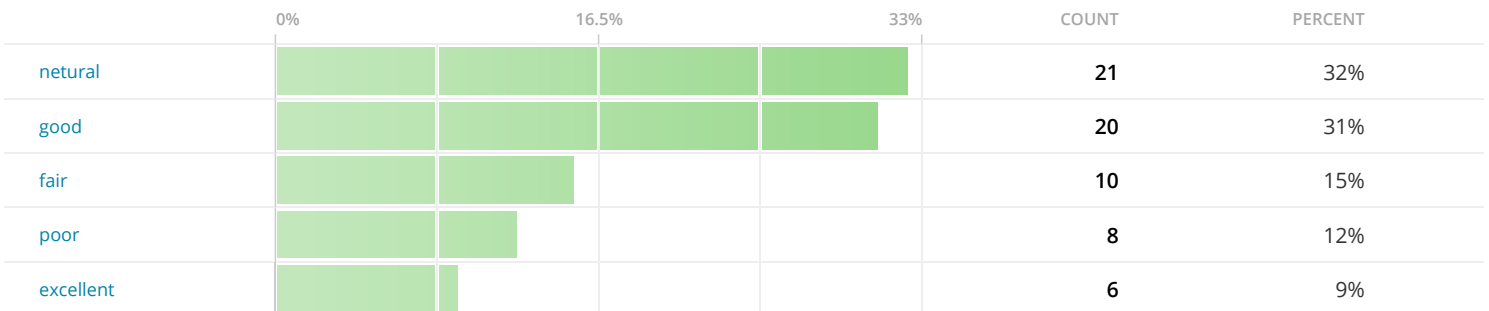


**Question 05**

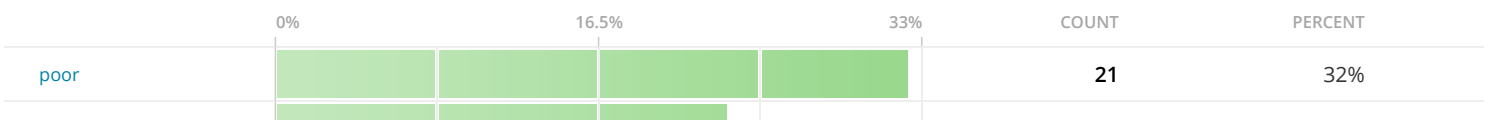


**Question 06**
